


Curriculum Resources (K-12)

The OISE Library's Curriculum Resource Collection contains over 36,000 resources to support K-12 instruction in all areas of the Ontario curriculum. The resources include but are not limited to: textbooks, manipulatives, resource kits, and teacher guides. All curriculum resources are located on the third floor of the library.

Find items by searching the library catalogue and refining results to "OISE Library" and then "Curriculum Resources".

Booking a Conference Room

Everyone is welcome to use the open space on the ground floor. However, there are study rooms that students can reserve either for personal study or for collaborative projects. The rooms can be booked in person at the reception desk or online by clicking the information icon at the front desk of the virtual tour.



Booking a Research Consultation

Book an individual consultation with an OISE librarian for assistance with topics including: searching for resources, evaluating resources, and managing citations. A research consultation can be booked online by clicking on the question mark button at the front reception on the virtual tour.

Ten Dell laptops are available on a first-come, first-served basis at the main reception area of the library. They can be borrowed in four hour time slots. 
